Adult Volunteers, Parents, & Cadets, I would like to welcome you to the North Texas 2026 Sea and League Cadet Advanced Trainings being held at **North Central Texas College (NCTC), 1525 W. California St, Gainesville, TX 76240**. Please read this letter thoroughly as it will provide you with all the details you will need to know about the trainings, logistics, and more. We will be conducting three training courses during this evolution: Sea Cadet Welding, Sea Cadet Construction, and League Cadet STEM/Seaperch.

Our training day will be spent at North Central Texas College, but since the dormitory we normally berth at is being remodeled, we will be berthing at Lone Oak Retreat, 8484 S. FM 372, Gainesville, TX. **Drop off, graduation, and pick-up will be at this site.**

Staff Cadets and Adults will arrive Saturday 20 June by 1400hrs. Cadet drop off will be Sunday 21 June from 1000-1200hrs. Any adult/cadet requiring airport pick-up must fly into Dallas/Fort Worth D/FW IAP or Dallas Love Field with arrival from 1000-1430 Sunday 21 June. You must notify COTC upon registration of flight arrangements and unfortunately, we will not be able to have unaccompanied minors where we must escort them to

and from their gate. We will be more than happy to pick up and drop off cadets who can navigate the airport on their own. Please check with your airline for unaccompanied minor policies. Departing flights from D/FW should be scheduled to depart no earlier than 1400hrs on Saturday 27 June. Pick-up will be right after graduation (0900) on Saturday 27 June 1100hrs.

Graduation will be held at Lone Oak Retreat. All personnel will report properly groomed and ready to start training immediately! Civilian clothes at check-in is allowed but cadets will change into uniform immediately after check-in. We will conduct PT each morning of training. Meals will be provided by/in the college dining facility. If you would like to serve as an escort officer or staff cadet, please contact the Site Lead (formerly COTC) at: rgfletcher84@gmail.com

Parent Portal - all prerequisites must be completed prior to issuance of any training order approvals. This is the parents' responsibility along with the Unit Commanding Officers'/designee to ensure these are completed, in accordance with regulations. Cadets will need to bring a copy of their signed/approved orders and ID Card. If any medication is to be administered during the training event, OTC or prescription, please ensure the appropriate documentation is completed in Magellan.

CO Rules should be reviewed by cadet and parent prior to departure. The sea bag list is provided; all cadets must report with the designated items only. Failure to report with the designated items will have a direct impact on your cadet's ability to participate to the fullest at this training. We will be going to the local municipal swimming pool for cadet recreation and the opportunity to practice their swim qualification!
